

Macarthur Disability Services - SWS Recovery College FORM: CovidSafe Conditions of Entry

As we return to face to face training, SWS Recovery College (SWSRC) / Macarthur Disability Services (MDS) have a Covid Safe Plan to prioritise the health and wellbeing of our staff, volunteers and students.

Exclusion Conditions: Staff, students and volunteers not permitted to attend training if they;

- Are feeling unwell or experiencing *any* [Covid-19 symptoms](#) (sore throat, runny nose, fever, cough, shortness of breath)
- Have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for Covid-19
- Are self-isolating whilst awaiting the results of a Covid-19 test or live with anyone who is awaiting the results of a Covid-19 test (including within 7 days of returning from overseas)
- Have tested positive on a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) or PCR Test – please follow [NSW Health guidelines](#) for confirmed cases

All attending students must adhere to the following;

- For training at MDS training room, Campbelltown: it is a requirement that all SWSRC staff and students are fully vaccinated – refer to [ATAGI definitions for NSW](#) (may be subject to change)
- For training at non-MDS venues: vaccination is not a requirement (unless the venue requires) and you may interact with non-vaccinated students. All SWSRC staff vaccinated.
- Complete a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) at home with negative result, prior to attending.
- QR Codes sign in is required at MDS training room. This will vary from venue to venue. SWSRC will also record attendance.
- Have temperature checked and recorded on attendance list upon arrival.
- Enter and exit via designated entry and exit points and if in a queue, maintain 1.5m social distancing.
- Wear a mask when arriving, departing or moving about the venue e.g. to go to bathroom. Masks are encouraged at all times however may be removed to speak and contribute during group and while seated it is preferable that students bring their own masks however they can be provided if required.
- Tables and chairs will be set up to provide a 1.5m spacing between students and staff (excluding those people attending who live together or have a close relationship). Tables and chairs must not be moved by students.
- Respond accurately to staff/volunteer questions related to the exclusion conditions above when registering and when arriving to the training session.
- Maintain good personal hygiene by washing hands regularly and thoroughly.
- Use the hand sanitiser provided upon arrival, exiting and re-entering room after breaks and when departing venue.
- Bring own water, refreshments and lunch and keep in own cool bag or purchase from local shops. Outside eating is encouraged where practical. Food, condiments, cups and cutlery will not be provided.
- Give consent to SWSRC / MDS (providing their name and contact details) to the NSW Department of Health or any other third party government department, as required to enable contact-tracing procedures.
- Acknowledge the right for SWSRC / MDS to refuse entry or request departure from the training if student is presenting with Covid-19 symptoms.

Please note;

- SWSRC / MDS staff/volunteers will also wipe down hard surfaces (e.g. door handles, tables and chairs, training resources) before and after usage.
- Gloves provided to students upon request.
- Room capacity limits apply: Students may be placed on a waiting list (advised prior to training start date).
